All materials used in our floors are sourced locally to manufacture, meaning a reduced carbon footprint. Not only that, but Karta floors are made using energy self-sufficient production.





Our Karta Plated® topcoat is made from natural, plastic-free resins, offering superior resistance against scratches and abrasion without compromising on sustainability.



Karta's wood fibre is sourced from recycled wood, wood waste, and parts of the tree not normally used in manufacturing. Cork is harvested from Quercus suber bark without felling or damage, and each tree can be harvested for up to 200 years.
